



Ceanothus 'Concha'

Medium to large mounding shrub 5-7' tall and 6-10' high. Dark, glossy green leaves to 1" with very showy cobalt blue flowers in tight clusters. Plant flowers in mid-spring for 2-3 weeks.



Ceanothus 'Dark Star'

Mounding shrub 4-6' tall and 5-6' wide. Leaves are tiny 1/4-1/2" with cobalt blue flowers in early spring. This variety is known for its fast growth habits.



Ceanothus 'Frosty Blue'

Medium to large mounding shrub 8-10' tall and 10-12' wide. Leaves are glossy green with serrated edges. Medium blue flowers with a frosted appearance, 3-4" clusters in early spring. This fast growing plants works well as a screen plant, and performs best for 10-12 years.



Ceanothus gloriosus- Point Reyes

Low spreading shrub 12-36" tall and 6' across. Deep green heavily toothed leaves to 1" on long arching branches. Flowers are blue to purple in large clusters along branches.



Ceanothus griseus horizontalis

This spreading shrub grows 2-3' tall and 10-12' wide, favored for its spreading habit. 1" pale blue flower clusters are found early to mid-spring.



Ceanothus griseus 'Louis Edmonds'

Spreading shrub growing to 5-6' tall and 10-15' wide. Flowers are deep blue in color.



Ceanothus 'Joyce Coulter'

Medium to large mounding shrub 3-5' tall and 8-10' wide. Medium to dark green leaves 1/2" wide by 1 1/2" long. Medium blue flowers are borne in mid-spring.



Ceanothus 'Julia Phelps'

Densely branched mounding shrub 5-6' tall and 6-8' wide. Small leaves 1/2" long on many intertwining branches. A very showy display of dark purple flowers in mid-spring.



Ceanothus 'Ray Hartman'

Large mounding shrub up to 15' tall and 10-15' wide. Large leaves 1-2" long, medium blue flowers in early spring. This variety can be trained into a small tree.



Ceanothus thysiflorus 'Snow Flurry'

Medium shrub growing to 8-10' high and wide. Large white flower clusters. This variety is not tolerant of heat and drought.

A Few Others That We Grow

Ceanothus 'Sierra Blue'

This large shrub or small tree grows 12-15' tall and 15' wide, heavy show of dark blue flowers in may. This is one of the better tree variety to use in hotter inland areas.

Ceanothus gloriosus 'Anchor Bay'

A groundcover variety growing 18" tall and 6' wide. Similar to regular gloriosus but growing much denser. Flowers are medium blue in color.

Ceanothus ssp. 'Porrectus'

This low growing variety grows 3' tall and 8' wide. Dark lavender flowers with leaves heavily toothed.

Ceanothus thyrsiflorus repens

This variety is low growing and widely spreading. Shiny foliage with pale blue flowers



Ceanothus thyrsiflorus 'Sky Lark'

This compact shrub grows 3-6' tall and wide. Leaves are small 1/4-1/2" and flowers are a medium blue.
