

Liquidambar

Liquidambar 'Burgundy'

Grows 60 ft. narrow and erect in its early years, with lower limbs eventually spreading to 20-25 ft. Tolerates damp soil and resistant to oak root fungus. Leaves turn deep purple-red and hang into late winter or even early spring if storms are not heavy.



Liquidambar 'Festival'

Grows to 60 ft. narrow and columnar. Tolerates damp soils and is resistant to oak root fungus. Light green foliage turns yellow, peach, pink, orange and red.



Liquidambar 'Palo Alto'

Grows to 60 ft. narrow and erect in youth, with lower limbs eventually spreading 20-25 ft. Tolerates damp soil and resistant to oak root fungus. Foliage turns orange-red to bright red in fall.



Liquidambar styraciflua

Grows to 60 ft. narrow and erect in youth with lower limbs eventually spreading 20-25 ft. tolerates damp soil and resistant to oak root fungus. Branching pattern, furrowed bark, corky wings on twigs and hanging fruit provide winter interest. In spring and summer leaves are rich green, turning purple, yellow and red in fall.
