### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Cotinus x coggygria</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP13,082; COPF open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Zone 4. (-30 °F or -34 °C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Light pink buds opening to pure white tubular flowers, which persist into fall.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Summer-fall. (Long Blooming Season)
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deciduous foliage. Fresh chartreuse to golden yellow spring foliage. Fall foliage is a flame of coral, orange and red tones.
<b>Habit:</b>	Rounded medium-large shrub. 8' x 6' at maturity.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Cuttings & Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun – part shade. Best foliage color in full sun
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Can be pruned to the ground each spring to encourage new strong stems & larger foliage.
<b>Uses:</b>	Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern mass landscape plantings.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>6-12 months from a 4" pot (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>3 Gallon</b>	<b>12-18 months from a 4" pot (Spring Planting).</b>

**Closest Variety:** C. 'Palace Purple'
